- Bar set up and tear down according to checklists and standards
- Mixes and prepares all beverages and items according to our recipes using proper measurements
- Serves alcoholic beverages in an appropriate manner consistent with company and ATC standards.
- Maintains a current permit and certification to sell alcoholic beverages.
- Never leaves the bar unless necessary.
- Greets all guests with enthusiasm and friendliness.
- Answers guest questions about food, beverages, and our facilities accurately and in a friendly manner.
- Does side work during non-busy hours.
- Speaks to guests with enthusiasm at all times.
- Develops relationships with guests.
- Provides the highest level of service in accordance with our standards.
- Identifies food orders when ready and delivers items to guests in a timely manner.
- Maintains a professional appearance at all times.
- Communicates with food and service staff to ensure guest satisfaction.
- Reports to work as scheduled, in uniform, and ready to be in position.
- Maintains professional relationships with all coworkers.
- Follows checklists and standard operating procedures.
- Maintains a safe, clean, organized, and stocked bar area.
- Performs duties as assigned.
- Maintains full knowledge of menus, recipes, cocktail recipes and other pertinent information.
- Constantly increases knowledge of food, beverages, and other products and services.
- Ensures that guests have a positive and memorable experience at Nine Irish Brothers.
- Responsible for constant sanitation, organization, and proper food handling.
- Prepares bar area for opening, mid-shift, or closing in accordance with company standards.
- Punches clock in full uniform, ready to work, and no earlier than five minutes prior to shift.

## REQUIREMENTS

- At least 21 years of age.
- Maintains a current state alcohol serving permit and ATC training.
- **Previous bartending or serving required.**
- Must be able to work flexible shifts and schedules, including weekends and some holidays.
- Must be able to lift and carry 85 pounds.
- Must be able to purchase a collared employee shirt upon hiring.
- Passion for Irish products, entertainment, and atmosphere.
- Must be able to stand, walk, lift, and bend for long periods of time.
- Must be able to demonstrate competency as outlined in the training schedule.
- Must have excellent people skills and an outgoing personality.
- Must be a team player who is cooperative and always willing to pitch in and help.
- Must be a hard worker.
- Must be honest.
